### ALL NEW STUDENTS MUST PRODUCE:

- Original Identity Documents
- Indemnity Form (available on the website at [www.dut.ac.za](http://www.dut.ac.za))
- Surety Form (available on the website at [www.dut.ac.za](http://www.dut.ac.za))
- Original NSC (Grade 12) Certificate / or relevant Tertiary Qualifications. Please note where the Senior certificates have not been released, the original results statement is required.
- CAO Number (First time entering students only)

### INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- International Students would be required to complete the manual registration process and are requested to present themselves at the registration venue on their respective registration date with the required documentation.
- Original Passport
- Study permit reflecting DUT as university of study.
- Proof of adequate medical cover with a registered South African medical scheme.
- Proof of Refugee Status/Asylum Seekers Permit (where applicable).
- Original Foreign qualification or SAQA approval
- If you are a first time entrant into the DUT, the letter advising you of acceptance into your academic programme.

### FINANCE

#### Payment for Non-Residence Students:

Minimum First Instalment: R3690 for Annual Registration (tuition only).  
Minimum First Instalment: R2260 for Semester Registration (tuition only).

#### Payment for Residence Students:

Minimum First Instalment: R7380 for Annual Registration (tuition and residence).  
Minimum First Instalment: R4530 for Semester Registration (tuition and residence).

**Direct Deposits** can be made into the DUT Bank Account:

Students who have a valid student number can deposit payments directly into the following bank account using the prescribed M65 (deposit slip) form. These forms are available at registration venues and cashier offices. (Also available on DUT website at [www.dut.ac.za](http://www.dut.ac.za))

Please note that there is a 5 working day period after the deposit is made before your account is credited.

If you are paying by **cheque**, it must be made out to the Durban University of Technology and must be crossed "not transferable"

#### Sponsored Students:

Similar letters must be produced in the case of bursaries or loans.
