## MYTH

- You can only run for elections if you affiliate with a political organisation or any club in the university.
- First year students can run for elections.
- If you come from another university or TVET and have a disciplinary record you can stand for elections.
- If you have a criminal record outside DUT you can run for elections.
- A candidate can pull out from the process once the final list of candidates is published.
- If you are a Midlands-registered student you can vote for a Durban registered candidate.
- If you are a Durban-registered student you can vote for a Midlands registered candidate.

A candidate cannot vote.

- Postgraduate students and students who are staff members cannot vote.
- A general student cannot object a candidate.
- All DUT registered students can vote.
- Once elected you can stay on the SRC even if you are on in-service training.

## **FACT**

- Any student with leadership qualities can run for elections as DUT recognises independent candidates.
- Only students who have been at the university for at least 2 semesters with 100% pass can run for SRC elections.
- A disciplinary record even from another university disqualifies you from standing for elections.
- A criminal record is an automatic disqualification for running for elections.
- Once the final list of candidates is issued, you cannot withdraw as a candidate.
- Midlands registered students can only vote for Midlands registered candidates.
- Durban registered students can only vote for Durban registered candidates.
- The candidate is also a voter and they can even vote for themselves.
- As long as you are a DUT student registered for a SENATE recognised course, you are eligible to vote.
- Any student can object a candidate provided they have justifiable grounds and can provide evidence.
- Only students registered for DUT SENATE approved courses can vote eg. students registered for short courses and courses like IMM cannot vote.
  - Students on in-service training are disqualified from serving in the SRC.
