- Provide proof of medical cover registered under the Medical Schemes Act 131 of 1998. It is therefore compulsory for international students to have a South African medical aid, which must be paid for upfront on an annual basis for the duration of your studies this does not apply to those on Asylum Seekers',
- Refugees, 'or Diplomats' visas.
